DLE@LLI will continue to promote candid, robust exchanges on timely topics through DLEx's signature Salons —invitation-only virtual events for GCs and senior innovation leaders. Michele DeStefano will continue as lead Faculty Advisor. Current DLEx members will automatically become LLI members through 2025. Entity members can participate in all LLI activities throughout their organizations. A dedicated DLE Executive Office, led by dual member Robert Dilworth, will ensure a smooth transition and support DLE activities.
