Key Facts for Media Outlets

- 1. Digital Legal Exchange (DLEx) and Liquid Legal Institute (LLI) are merging effective April 1, 2025. DLEx will operate within LLI as the "Digital Leaders Exchange [at] LLI" (DLE [at] LLI). Both organizations were founded in 2018 and have complementary missions focused on legal transformation in the digital era.
- 2. This strategic combination creates the world's premier global forum for legal transformation at a critical time as AI and digital technologies fundamentally reshape the legal profession.
- 3. This unites the world's two leading legal transformation think tanks under the LLI name, combining 1,500+ members from 140+ companies and organizations across 20+ countries. The combined organization represents all major economic sectors and the legal ecosystem through a multi-disciplinary, intergenerational membership.
- 4. DLE [at] LLI will be led by Bill Deckelman (Chairman) and Mark A. Cohen (Chairman Emeritus), with a dedicated Executive Office headed by Robert Dilworth.
- 5. Current DLEx members will be offered a LLI corporate membership, and entity members can engage their colleagues in a wide range of LLI transformation activities appropriate to their organizations' various levels.
- 6. DLE [at] LLI will continue DLEx's signature Salons invitation-only virtual events for General Counsels and other senior legal sector innovation leaders.
- 7. DLE [at] LLI aims to host at least 2 physical events in Germany, UK or the US.
- 8. The DLE is supported by a distinguished group of more than 70 experts in the field, united under a Faculty Advisory Program. The FA Program is directed by Michele DeStefano.
- Initial joint projects and events include a book publication ("Liquid Legal Sustaining the Rule of Law") on May 9 (featuring chapters by several dual DLEx-LLI members), private GC summits at Legal Tech Talk 2025 (London, June 26-27) and LLI's Summit (Düsseldorf, July 7-8), and a collaborative white paper on GenAI-era legal sector talent.
